Dear parent/carer,

As you will be aware, external examinations for Year 10 have begun this week with Welsh oral examinations. We would like to congratulate all of Year 10 for their excellent conduct and commitment to this examination; they were a credit to themselves and to the school.

As was outlined in previous communication to parents and carers, the arrangements for students to sit their Unit One English Literature examination on Monday 13th May are as follows:

- Students should arrive at school no later than 8:30am. Any lateness to school will mean that students will not be able to complete their examination.

- Students should ensure that they bring examination equipment: a clear pencil case, pen, pencil, ruler and highlighter.
