Free School Meals

Children whose families are on lower incomes and qualify for certain benefits can apply for free school meals. Further information together with a link to the application process can be found here:

Free school meals

As the applying parent or carer, you must be receiving one of the following:

- Income Support
- Jobseeker's Allowance (income based)
- Employment Support Allowance (income related)
- Child Tax Credit, with a household income of £16,190 or less
- Pension Credit (guarantee element)
- Universal Credit with net household earnings of less than £7,400
- *Families who receive Working Tax Credit do not qualify

School Essentials Grant

Children whose families are on lower incomes and qualify for certain benefits can also apply for a grant of £125 per learner or £200 for learners entering year 7 (to help with increased costs associated with starting secondary school). All compulsory school years from reception to year 11 are now eligible.

All looked after children qualify for the grant, whether they receive free school meals or not. Learners who receive free school meals due to transitional protection arrangements do not qualify. The grant can be spent on:

- School sports kit including footwear;
- IT equipment: laptop and tablets ONLY (School Essentials should only be used in limited situations where a school is unable to loan equipment to the family);
- Uniform for enrichment activities, including but not limited to: scouts; guides; cadets; martial arts; sports; performing arts, or dance;
- Equipment for example, school bags and stationery;
- Specialist equipment where new curriculum activities begin such as design and technology;
- Equipment for out-of-school hours trips such as outdoor learning for example, waterproofs
