Dear Parents and Carers,

Re: Year 11 Prom – Cardiff City Football Stadium

We are delighted to inform you that the Year 11 Prom will be held on **Friday 27th June** at the prestigious **Cardiff City Football Stadium**. This is an exciting opportunity for our Year 11 students to celebrate their achievements and mark the end of their compulsory education at Whitchurch High School in style.

The evening will commence at **7:00 PM** and conclude at **11:00 PM**. It promises to be a memorable event filled with music, dancing, and refreshments. The dress code for the evening is formal, and we encourage students to embrace the occasion with their best attire.

Tickets for the event are priced at **£45** per person. This includes entry to the venue, a buffet dinner, security services and entertainment throughout the evening. Tickets will be available for purchase via ParentPay and a deposit of £20 should be paid by Monday 3rd March. Final payments should be made by Friday 18th April at the latest, however should this time frame cause any issues, then please contact Mr Horgan on the email address below.

To ensure the safety and enjoyment of all attendees, we kindly request that students make appropriate transport arrangements to and from the venue. Please inform us if there are any specific dietary requirements or accessibility needs that we should accommodate.

The Year 11 Prom is a significant milestone and a chance for our students to create lasting memories with their peers. As we are committed to making this event a wonderful celebration, the Year 11 Student Forum have met and agreed the following stipulations that students must adhere to in order to secure their invitation.

- An attendance figure of over 90% from January 6th until the 9th May. Where students are not able to meet this attendance figure due to individual circumstances, then a reasonable target will be given. The Progress Team will also consider students' achievement points and personal circumstances when making a final decision regarding attendance.
- Students should have a good behaviour record over the year and conform to the expectations of the Ready to Learn policy. This includes attendance at sanctions such as Level 2 detentions and extension to the school day.
- Students who receive high tariff levels (Level 3, 4 and 5) and who are referred to our internal ready to learn room on more than two occasions between the dates specified (January 6th until the 9th May) may jeopardise their place at prom.
- Students who have received a fixed term exclusion this academic year have jeopardised their place at the prom.
