Dear Parents and Carers,

We have been made aware of recent social media activity encouraging pupils to take part in inter-school violence next week. As a precautionary safeguarding measure, the school is working closely with the Local Authority and partner agencies to ensure appropriate preventative steps are in place.

We would like to reassure families that this social media activity is not specific to our school or to Cardiff alone, but reflects a national trend currently being monitored across the UK.

If your child feels anxious about attending school, please reassure them that their safety remains our priority and that the school day will continue as normal. Staff are aware of the issue and are taking proportionate steps to maintain a safe and calm environment for all pupils.

We would ask parents and carers to actively discourage their children from engaging with or sharing such content, and to remind them of the serious consequences of involvement in or promotion of violence. Any behaviour that places pupils or others at risk would be treated as a serious breach of the school's behaviour and safeguarding policies and could result in sanctions, as well as potential involvement from external agencies.

Thank you for your continued support in helping us keep our school community safe.
