## **PROMISES**

\*LT Feedback system: Exclusive too myself, essentially is an anonymous google form which would be active for 2 weeks (on a cycle) where all responses will be relayed to the progress team, headteacher, senior staff etc at the fortnightly meeting, this is a new way of ensuring we get a say and persistently at that, where I feel past teams haven't always been consistent in communicating and doing so.

\*Level system: Balancing independence v responsibility, 6<sup>th</sup> form team agrees the language of levels isn't always appropriate. Feedback system may be good way of giving us some insight into potential changes (Can't remove SIMS though)

\*Phone policy: This is currently being reviewed for September by senior staff, I want to make sure we don't follow suit of other schools in the UK where they must lock their phones away when entering and are given them back at end of day.

\*Furnishment of common room: dependant on success of fundraising though should be possible, feedback system would be used to see what people want.

Table Tennis tournaments: Would be on termly basis, perhaps we could add prizes to this too?

General fundraising: Things like Culture Day and typical staff run events, I would like to introduce more unique events personally.

Breakfast before exams: A-levels are categorically harder and more strenuous but we don't have this privilege whereas some GCSES do, we would all benefit from just having this option open.

Just typical things: Socials, bakes sales/charity work, end of yr events etc. Feedback system useful to decide themes for socials and Charity to support?

## **WHY SHOULD I BELIEVE YOU WILL FULFILL THESE?**
